Jury urges execution for cult leader who ordered 5 deaths

PAINESVILLE, Ohio - Jurors who sat through a rambling sermon by Jeffrey Lundgren dismissed his claims of divine authority yesterday and recommended he be put to death as a murderer.

The jury deliberated slightly

more than two hours, including time for lunch, before recommending that Lundgren be executed for the deaths of the Dennis Avery family.

Lundgren, who for five hours Wednesday sought to convince the jury that he is the world's last prophet, showed no emotion. The jury's recommendation of death

was read five times by Judge Martin O. Parks, once for each member of the Avery family, whose bodies, bound with duct tape, were found buried inside a barn in Kirtland, Ohio.

Parks said he would formally sentence Lundgren today. Neither Lundgren nor his attorneys had any comment.

Lundgren, his wife and son were among 13 cult members arrested early this year after the Averys' bodies were found. The Averys also were members of the cult.

Lundgren's 19-year-old son, Damon, was convicted Tuesday of four counts of aggravated murder and four counts of kidnapping, and could be sentenced to death. His

sentencing hearing is Monday.

Jeffrey Lundgren's wife, Alice, 39, was sentenced to five life prison terms after being convicted of conspiracy, complicity and kidnap-
