PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Pennsylvania:

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since

11th September, anno Domini 1900, and in the State of Pennsylvania, continuously next preceding the date of this petition,

since the 12th day of September, anno Domini 1900, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the
