To the Honorable the District Court of the United States for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania:

The petition of *Mario Andrade*

First. My place of residence is *2433 Grandview Avenue Philadelphia Pa.*

Second. My occupation is *Painter*

Third. I was born on the *5* day of *March*, anno Domini *1895*, at *Barre, Vermont*

Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from *Venezuela* on or about the *14* day of *May*, anno Domini *1909*, and arrived in the United States, at the port of *Philadelphia*, on the vessel *Province*

Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the *11* day of *April*, anno Domini *1912*

at *Philadelphia*, in the *Court of Common Pleas*

Sixth. I am *Married*. My wife's name is *Helen*; she was born on the *15* day of *Aug*, anno Domini *1887*

at *Charlottesville, Virginia*, and now resides at *do*

I have *2* children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to *VICTOR EMANUEL III, KING OF ITALY*, of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the *20* day of *Nov*, anno Domini *1909*, and in the State of Pennsylvania, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the *20* day of *Sept*, anno Domini *1909*, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the *Court of Common Pleas*, on the *11* day of *April*, anno Domini *1912*, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit,

, and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
