The petition of Leone Paroni respectfully shows:

First. My full name is Leone Paroni

Second. My place of residence is number 3615 Osage street, city of Denver

Third. My occupation is Stone mason

Fourth. I was born on the 22nd day of June, anno Domini 1870, at Forn Di Sopra, Udine, Italy

Fifth. I emigrated to the United States from Narre France on or about the 14th day of March

anno Domini 1890, and arrived at the port of New York New York in the United States, on the vessel Lea cogue

Sixth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 10th day of October

at Denver, Colorado in the County Court of within and for the City and County

Seventh. I am not married. My wife's name is _____ She was born _____

Eighth. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in organized government. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy of which at this time I am a citizen subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Ninth. I am able to speak the English language.

Tenth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for a term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 2nd day of March, anno Domini 1890 and in the State of Colorado for one year at least next preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 26th day of August, anno Domini 1900

Eleventh. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. I made petition for citizenship to the _____ Court of _____ at _____ on the _____ day of _____, anno Domini 1 _____, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit, _____
